Role

- Teach the whole school the required talks, songs and actions
- Confidently lead workshops through communication, tech and sound
- To cultivate excellent relationships with children, staff and parents during the school day, offering additional Rock Kidz products when the opportunity arises
- To liaise with the Rock Kidz head office when required
- Respond to correspondence from the Rock Kidz team within 24 hours
- Take care of equipment provided and report any issues in a timely manner
